AMENDMENT PROJECT

- 1. Creativity is very, very, important for this project.
- 2. You are expected to create an amendment picture book.
- 3. Pick 15 amendments to include in this book.
- 4. You will include a cover that introduces your reader to your project, be as creative as you want with this.
- 5. Each page will include:
 - a. The title of the amendment -top of the page
 - b. An explanation, *in your own words*, of what the amendment means and/or does *bottom of page*
 - c. A **picture** that correctly displays the meaning **visually** (a drawing, a picture from the internet, magazine, etc...but remember it must be color) *middle of page*
 - i. An example would be a picture of Speedy Gonzalez sitting in the witness stand for the right to a speedy trial.
- 6. We will go over each amendment individually in class, so you are expected to take notes on each one
- 7. You will be graded on the following:
 - a. A cover -15 points
 - b. 15 amendments are included 15 points
 - c. Each amendment has a title 15 points
 - d. Each amendment has an explanation *in your own words* 15 points
 - e. Each amendment has a picture to represent it -15 points
 - f. It is neat and professional 15 points
 - g. It uses color 10 points
